



SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT REPORT (2014 - 2018)

The King's College has achieved the following during the 2014 to 2018 period -

- 1 Increased student enrolments by 95%.
- 2 The number of staff employed has doubled from 29 to 62.
- 3 The College has double-streamed - Kindergarten, Pre-Primary, Year 1, Year 7 and Year 8.
- 4 We have built a new Administration building.
- 5 Redeveloped the Early Learning Centre - including a new ablution block.
- 6 Manufactured two prefabricated classrooms.
- 7 Engineered a new undercover area.
- 8 Constructed a second primary playground.
- 9 Commenced work on a nature playground for Kindergarten and Pre-Primary.
- 10 Initiated the one-to-one laptop program in Years 7-10.
- 11 Introduced a pod of Ipads for students in Kindergarten to Year 6.
- 12 Increased College internet speed from 10 MB/s to an aggregate of 120 MB/s.
- 13 Employed a full-time College Chaplain.
- 14 Introduced the Therapy Dog program.
- 15 Started social justice initiatives - Raven Soup Patrol, Community Choir and Women's Refuge.
- 16 Enhanced extra-curricular activities to include more than 15 clubs.
- 17 Expanded the Emergency Services Cadet Unit to over 100 cadets.
- 18 Employed a Librarian and increased library resources.
- 19 Developed a Reading Room (Pre-Primary to Year 6).
- 20 More than doubled subjects offered in Years 11 and 12.
- 21 Introduced Certificate II courses for Year 10s in Sport & Recreation and Music Industry.
- 22 Founded Kings Worship Academy (KWA).
- 23 The College now has three choirs and two worship teams.
- 24 Over 60 students participate in instrumental and vocal tuition.
- 25 In the Community Health Audit - 100% of staff reported that they enjoyed going to work.
